One grant is awarded per qualifying STCA Junior Member per year with a maximum amount of \$500.

Eligible juniors must be 10 to 18 years of age, be an STCA Junior Member, and handling a Scottish Terrier. The Junior as per AKC Rules must own dogs. Record one point each for each junior handler defeated in your class. (Do not include yourself).

Best Junior Handler: Record one point for each handler defeated in all classes. (Do not include yourself).

A 25-point bonus will be awarded for the first junior handler to qualify for The AKC Classic. Juniors must have 5 first place wins in an Open Class, with competition present. Juniors must have a grade point average of at least a 3.0 or equivalent for the two semesters completed immediately prior to the closing of entries. GPA must be verified by official school transcript or home school information.

A 25-point bonus will be awarded for the first junior handler to qualify for Eukanuba. Juniors must have 5 first place wins in an Open Class, with competition present.

A 25-point bonus will be awarded for the first handler to qualify for Westminster. Juniors must have placed first in ten or more Open Classes where there was competition.
