

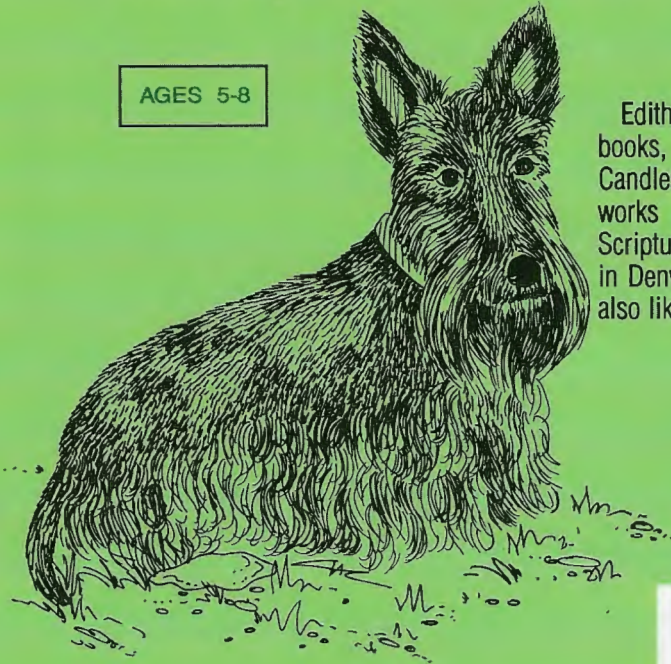
The Adventures Of DONNECHAD'S PIPER
